



# Conditional Lineman Rules

## IBEW Local 1393

---

1. Confirm hours and time (42 months) in Trade (must have 4,000 hours in Distribution).
2. Working in Local 1393 jurisdiction as a "Conditional Lineman" for 6 months.
3. Conditional Lineman cannot oversee Apprentices or be assigned as Foreman or work outside state of Indiana.
4. The Local will send a request for application for Journeyman Lineman Examination mailed to Conditional Lineman at the start of the 5<sup>th</sup> month.
5. Application for Journeyman Lineman Examination must be returned by the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> month and scheduled for testing in the 7<sup>th</sup> month.
6. Should no application for Journeyman Lineman Examination be returned by the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> month, a letter will be mailed to Conditional Lineman to appear in front of Local Executive Board on the 7<sup>th</sup> month.
7. The Conditional Lineman will be given until the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> month to return Lineman application, at which time they will be scheduled for testing in the 8<sup>th</sup> month.
8. Conditional Lineman status will be removed at the end of 8<sup>th</sup> month by Executive Board motion should Conditional Lineman not comply with rules. Notice will be provided to the Member and the Employer.
9. The Members' status as a Conditional Lineman will be revoked and the member must enroll in the ALBAT apprenticeship program.
